

“Like sands through the hourglass, so are the days of our lives”. Who would have thought that the preamble from a well-known soap opera could open our reflection for this Sunday! But wisdom sometimes takes what is the most banal to express a truism we would rather choose to ignore, namely, “Vanity of vanities, all is vanity”.

For all our work and toil, the sleepless nights of worry and the sapping energies spent clinging on to and fighting for what seemed so important, but (with hoary heads we look back at the way we were, or “as mourners... already walking to and fro...before the dust returns to earth from whence it came, and with closing sigh to God revert) now wonder why we bothered: “Vanity of vanities...All is vanity” (cf. Ecclesiastes 12:5, 7-8).

“What do we gain for all our efforts?” asks the sage (cf. Ecclesiastes 3:9). Whether we be “full many a flower...born to blush unseen and waste its sweetness on the desert air” or among “All that beauty, all that wealth e'er gave, awaits the inevitable hour. The paths of glory lead but to the grave” (cf. poem by Thomas Gray), humanity’s unremitting hunger ends in death; our lives an epitaph etched in stone or on a plaque to say for a time we had passed this way, but now, “Vanity of vanities, all is vanity and the chasing of the wind” (cf. Ecclesiastes 2:11)!

This is the wisdom that spills over into our gospel reading today, contained in God’s rebuke that is both prophetic, but all too crushing: “Fool! This very night the demand will be made for your soul; and the hoard that is yours, whose will it be then?” For all is vanity and the chasing of the wind.

But all is not lost. There is hope. For in God’s rebuke there is also a promise if we are wise; a secret which has been made known: that life is changed, not ended; that what is mortal will put on immortality and what is perishable, perishability (cf. 1 Corinthians 15:51-53). After all, in the words of our second reading, we “have been brought back to true life with Christ”; that when he is revealed we will be revealed in all our glory with him, since “There is only Christ: he is everything and he is in everything”. To him, then, be glory for ever.

## Responsorial Psalm 89


R. In every age, O Lord, you have been our refuge.

## SMOA Church App


