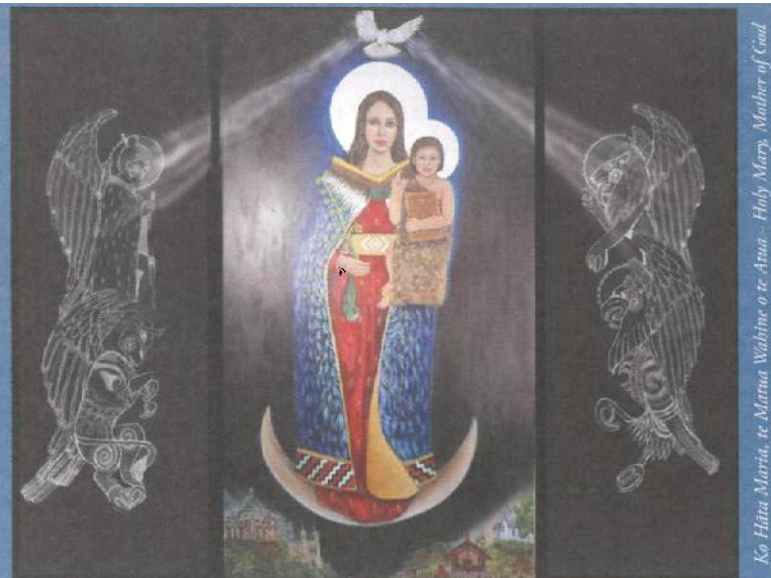

On the 24<sup>th</sup> of November I will be leaving St Mary of the Angels to take up a new and permanent appointment in Christchurch.

This new appointment did not come as a surprise to me as I knew I would be shifting in the New Year of 2026. However, what did catch me by surprise was the speed with which it needs to be implemented! I thought I would have more time to make my goodbyes and say 'thank you' to the many people of the parish who have made my time as parish priest here at St Mary of the Angels so memorable and so enjoyable.

Much has changed in the parish in those six years. I began as parish priest at the beginning of 2020. Just a few months later the Covid virus hit and caused such disruption, pain and heartache to our community and all others in New Zealand.

Then, in response to the Covid virus, the Bishops of New Zealand chose St Mary of the Angels church as the National Shrine, a special place to pray for Mary's protection for all who live in Aotearoa New Zealand. The image, 'Ko Hata Maria', commemorating this choice, is now at the back of the church.

There were other changes too. As a parish we celebrated the 100th anniversary of the building of the church. Our cherished, beautiful, iconic St Mary of the Angels church was built by Fr. Stan Mahony sm after the First World and was opened in 1922. Our celebrations for this occasion were rather muted because Covid was still present amongst in 2022.

We also undertook to complete the renovation of the parish offices and hall – a real financial challenge in difficult times. But we succeeded! Approximately \$1.2 million was raised for this project and now we and many others are enjoying the benefits.

Above all the community at St. Joseph's joined us and so we became one parish together. Together, our two communities cover the inner city from Hataitai to the University and provide facilities and opportunities for worship and service that are welcomed by a wide range of people searching for God.

I mention these changes, each important in their own way, as evidence of how vibrant the parish is and how committed the parishioners. And this is why I want to thank each one of you for what you bring to our community and the support you have offered me over the past six years. It has been a joy and a privilege to walk with you in faith as we have experienced together the highs and the lows of life in Wellington and in our parish. Inadequate as these few words are I want you to know that I will carry so many wonderful memories with me. St Mary of the Angels will always have a special place in my heart,

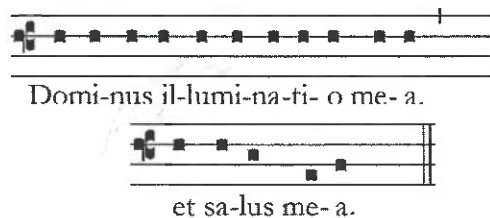
### Responsorial Psalm 45
