

Waitangi Day Mass

The Waitangi Day Mass will be celebrated this Friday 6 February at 9am. The celebrant will be Monsignor Gerard Burns, the Vicar General for Maori. The Mass will include prayers and hymns in Maori, English, Latin and other languages.

A feature of St Mary of the Angels is the special artwork presenting Mary, dressed as a woman of Aotearoa with places connected with the history of the Church here, including Te Tu marae in Waitangi.

This will be the only Mass in the Church on Waitangi Day.


